Squijd is an application that lets you capture and send bits of your computer desktop to your phone.

Use it to copy travel directions, a recipe idea, family pictures, notes of things to remember - the list is endless.

Anything you can see on your computer you can now send to your (or a friend's!) phone.

Installation

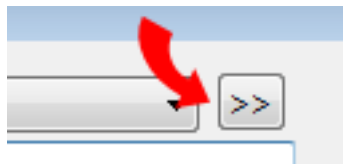
Install the PC or Mac program on your computer.

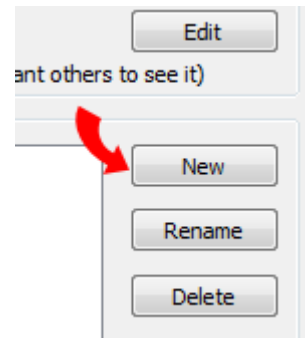

Getting Started

1. Run the Squijd.exe PC program.
2. On the Computer Squijd App, Click "Send".
3. On the Computer Squijd App, Add a new device by selecting the ">>" button.



4. On the Computer Squijd App, Click "New".



5. Install and run the Squijd iPhone App.
6. On the iPhone App, select the setting icon and select "Register Computer".



7. Copy the "Phone Name" and "Passcode" entries from the iPhone to the PC, also choosing a name for this iPhone.
8. On the PC Squijd App, Select OK twice to return to the Send Squijd dialog.
9. On the PC Squijd App, Select "Send". A Squijd will be sent to your iPhone.

(On the PC, the Squijd App will minimise to the system tray.)
